CITY MANAGER:

Food Truck Tuesday August 7th:

Final logistics for Food Truck Tuesday on August 7th are being made. The following food vendors will be present: Inday's, Fiesta Fresh, Holy Crepe, The Lamb & Wolf, Urban Outlaw, the Sugar Bar Co., and Slyderz. A bounce house will be sponsored by the City of Corning and Gonzalez Jumpers. Additional tables and a shade canopy are being rented. A few of the instructors for the Corning Recreation Program will be constructing a craft and providing outreach regarding the Corning Recreation Program. Posters publicizing the event have been posted throughout town and numerous Facebook postings have been made.

Sales Tax Reports:

I met with Hinderliter, de Llamas (HdL) on July 31st regarding sales tax projections for the 1st Quarter of 2018. Overall Transaction and Use Tax (Measure A) revenues are up 4.9% totaling \$11,883 as compared to the 1st Quarter of 2017. The State of California implemented new finance software that is delaying some sales tax filings. After these adjustments are made, it is anticipated 1st Quarter 2018 sales tax will be down 1.1% or \$7,980 compared to the 1st Quarter of 2017. The decline is due to a decrease in auto and truck sales.

Economic Development:

There will be an Economic Development Action Committee Meeting on August 6th at Dignity Health beginning at 8:45 AM. I will be attending a Tehama County Economic Development Meeting to discuss barriers and progress on August 10th.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

City Roof Repair:

Roofing Contractor Dan DeLany has informed the Public Works Department that the roof sheeting for the Corporation Yard shop roof is expected to be delivered by August 10, 2018. He is tentatively scheduled to resume work by Monday. He also has a contractor ready to finish repairs to the City Hall break room ceiling. His contractor will be starting work on the kitchen/break room ceiling repair today.

Vandalism:

Once again several sprinklers located at the Corning Community Park (Skate Park/Lennox Fields) were destroyed by vandals. They also left graffiti on the snack bar and cement.

Waterline Extension:

Able Construction is scheduled to begin work on trench repairs Monday, August 6th.

Meetings/Training:

Robin Kampmann, NorthStar Engineering City Consultant, will be meeting with Ed Anderson and Public Works Director Dawn Grine on August 15th to review and be "brought up to speed" on the City history, recent and current projects.

Water Consultant Win Benbow was in Corning today training with the City water operators.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 229 calls for service, a total of 49 officer reports were taken and there were 169 officer-initiated incidents, including 83 traffic stops. Officers made 16 misdemeanor and 4 felony arrests. Officers issued 46 citations, of which; 19 were misdemeanors, 22 were infractions, 1 was parking-related, 2 were animal-related, and 2 were unclassified during the period of July 25, 2018 through August 1, 2018.

Training:

Officers continue to participate in POST Portal training and Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. Other Officer Field Training and Dispatcher Training is continuing.

Our thoughts are with everyone who has been affected by the Carr Fire. The ramifications of this devastation will be felt by the entire north State for many years to come. Corning Police Department has been, and is currently, assisting on the Carr Fire since the initial emergency request.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:**Call Volume:**

The Corning Volunteer Fire Department responded to 21 calls for service last week. These consisted of: 18 medical aids, 1 fire, 1 public service call, and 1 gas leak.

There were also 13 calls dispatched for Orland and Capay Fire Departments; these consisted of 7 medical aids, 4 fires, 1 public service call and 1 downed power lines.

Training:

Department Volunteer training consisted of ladder truck use and review of properly taking blood pressure.

Mutual Aid/Strike Team:

1 engine and 3 members from the Department continue working on the Carr Fire.
