### CITY MANAGER:

#### **Negotiation of Digital Path Tower Lease Agreement**

The Digital Path Tower Lease Agreement will be presented to the City Council at the July 25<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting. The City will receive an additional ~\$6,000 annually as part of this new lease agreement.

#### **Franchise Hauling Agreement with Waste Management, Inc (Corning Disposal)**

The City's franchise hauling agreement with Waste Management expires March 31, 2018. Staff is negotiating with Waste Management while keeping its options open regarding a joint RFP for franchise hauling services with the County. Waste Management will be providing a response to the City's concerns next week. I will provide more information as it becomes available.

#### **Economic Development Action meeting**

I attended the Economic Development Action meeting on July 10<sup>th</sup> whereby additional community events on a regular basis such as Movies in the Park and transportation issues to local colleges was discussed. 3CORE is conducting initial research regarding the transportation problem to make a business case to resolve the issue. A Façade Improvement grant program managed by the City, but funded by local community banks was also discussed.

I will be attending a Proposition 47 grant meeting in Sacramento on July 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 308 calls for service, a total of 35 officer reports were taken and there were 98 officer-initiated incidents, including 40 traffic stops. Officers made 15 misdemeanor arrests and 4 felony arrests. Officers issued 22 citations, of which; 3 were infractions and 19 were misdemeanors during the period of July 5, 2017 through July 12, 2017.
