### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **FY 2017/18 Budget:**

The City Council approved the FY 2017/2018 Budget as presented to the Council on June 13, 2017 at its regularly scheduled June 27, 2017 meeting.

#### **Janitorial Services Agreement:**

Public Works Director Dawn Grine and I met with Tehama County Public Works Director Gary Antone to negotiate the Janitorial Services Agreement. Due to vandalism issues, the County agreed to fund a security system at the Transportation Center. City Staff will obtain estimates for a security system to present to the County.

#### **High School Parking Lot Agreement:**

Corning High School Superintendent John Burch and I met on June 29<sup>th</sup> to negotiate the parking lot lease for approximately 279 parking stalls (~3 acres) on City owned land across from the High School. The parking lot will be constructed sometime in the next year, but not over this summer.

#### **Street Closure:**

Harvest Christian Center has submitted its annual request to close South Street between 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Link Street from 6:30 p.m. until 10 p.m. on Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup> for their annual (free) fireworks display. This request is approved and a notice has been sent to local emergency services regarding the street closure.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:****Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 241 calls for service, a total of 30 officer reports were taken and there were 105 officer-initiated incidents, including 21 traffic stops. Officers made 7 misdemeanor arrests and 6 felony arrests. Officers issued 16 citations, of which; 8 were misdemeanors, 3 were felonies, 1 was an infraction, 1 was animal-related, 2 were parking-related, and 1 was unclassified during the period of June 21, 2017 through June 28, 2017.
