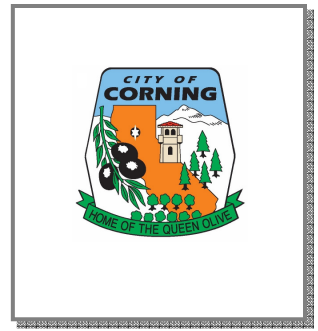


AFFIDAVIT – CERTIFICATION OF INSTALLATION CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS

Section R315.2.2 of the 2013 California Residential Code, Title 24 Part 2.5:

“When a permit is required for alterations, repairs or additions with a total cost or calculated valuation exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000), existing dwellings or sleeping units with a fossil fuel burning heater or appliance, fireplace, or an attached garage shall have a carbon monoxide alarm installed in accordance with section R315.2. Carbon monoxide alarms shall only be required in the specific dwelling unit or sleeping unit for which the permit was obtained.”

Carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed in the following locations:

1. Outside of each separate dwelling unit sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
2. On every level of a dwelling unit including basement.

Multi-purpose alarms: Carbon monoxide alarms combined with smoke alarms shall comply with Section R315.3.1, all applicable standards, and requirements for listing and approval by the Office of the State Fire Marshall, for smoke alarms.

Power Supply: In dwelling units where there is no commercial power supply, the carbon monoxide alarm(s) may be solely battery operated R315.1.1 (exception 1.) In existing dwelling units, a carbon monoxide alarm is permitted to be solely battery operated where repairs or alterations do not result in the removal of wall and ceiling finishes or there is no access by means of attic, basement or crawl space Section R315.1.1 (exception 2).

As owner of the above-referenced property, I hereby certify that carbon monoxide alarm(s) have been installed in accordance with the manufacturer’s instructions and in compliance with section R315 of the 2013 California Building Code, Title 24 Part 2.5.
